

Descriptive adjectives

Regular adjectives

We usually call regular adjectives the masculine adjectives that ends with:

I T D L S

For the **feminine form** of these adjectives, simply add an: E

****If the masculine form ends with an e, It stays the same in the fem. Sing.**

EX : jeune - timide

For the Masculine plural form of these adjectives, simply add an: ES

For the Feminine plural form of these adjectives, simply add an: ES

Irregular adjectives

If the masculine form ends with :

Masculine	Feminine	Example:
<u>eux</u>	<u>euse</u>	<u>sérieux - sérieuse</u>
<u>el</u>	<u>elle</u>	<u>ponctuel - ponctuelle</u>
<u>if</u>	<u>ive</u>	<u>Sportif - sportive</u>
<u>on</u>	<u>onne</u>	<u>migon - mignonne</u>

Adjectives Positions

Most adjectives come after the noun they modify...

Ex: J'ai des amis sympathiques

BUT!!! Some adjectives come before the noun.

Ex: J'ai une petite voiture.

Adjectives that come before the noun are called **BAGS**

Examples:

B Beauty

A Age

G Goodness

S Size
